Duties

- Service and repair equipment in the shop and on-site for the customer.
- Recondition and remanufacture components as required for equipment, engine, and hydraulic repairs.

- Communicate equipment servicing needs as required with Supervisor/Manager.
- Communicate work performed and complete service paperwork.
- Update and maintain service records.
- Fill out warranty information.
- Complete work orders.
- Participate in all required Health & Safety Training.
